## Sunny Wolf Charter School Title I Family Involvement Policy

On an annual basis Sunny Wolf Charter School will make available the following opportunities for involvement to the families we serve:

- 1- During our annual Fall Open House event we give a talk to disseminate current Title I information. Information is available regarding funding, how resources are spent, what academic areas we target, and staff support.
- 2- We host several opportunities each year to bring families on campus, including our annual Spring into the Arts Celebration, Dr. Seuss Read-a-thon, and S.T.E.A.M. Carnival. Our family events are an opportunity for students and families to celebrate our academic offerings and achievements and participate together in educational activities. At these events we can also provide detailed information to parents about our Title I program and the ways it benefits all Sunny Wolf Charter School students.
- 3- We offer flexibility to families by scheduling events at varying times. We place information about our family events on our website, newsletters, flyers and on our Sunny Wolf Charter School Facebook page. We also contact families by email, text and phone.
- 4- When requested we provide information regarding Title I services during Parent-Teacher Conferences twice per year. At these conferences we can share more detailed information about reading & math groups, assessment, growth and next steps for individual students. We have well attended conferences where parents have the opportunity to discuss concerns.
- 5-Our teachers make themselves available afterschool, before school and via email to all of our parents. We have Student Study Teams that meet as needed to discuss any student concerns. Parents are invited to call a meeting if they have any concerns regarding their student.
