- *All students are eligible to receive services*

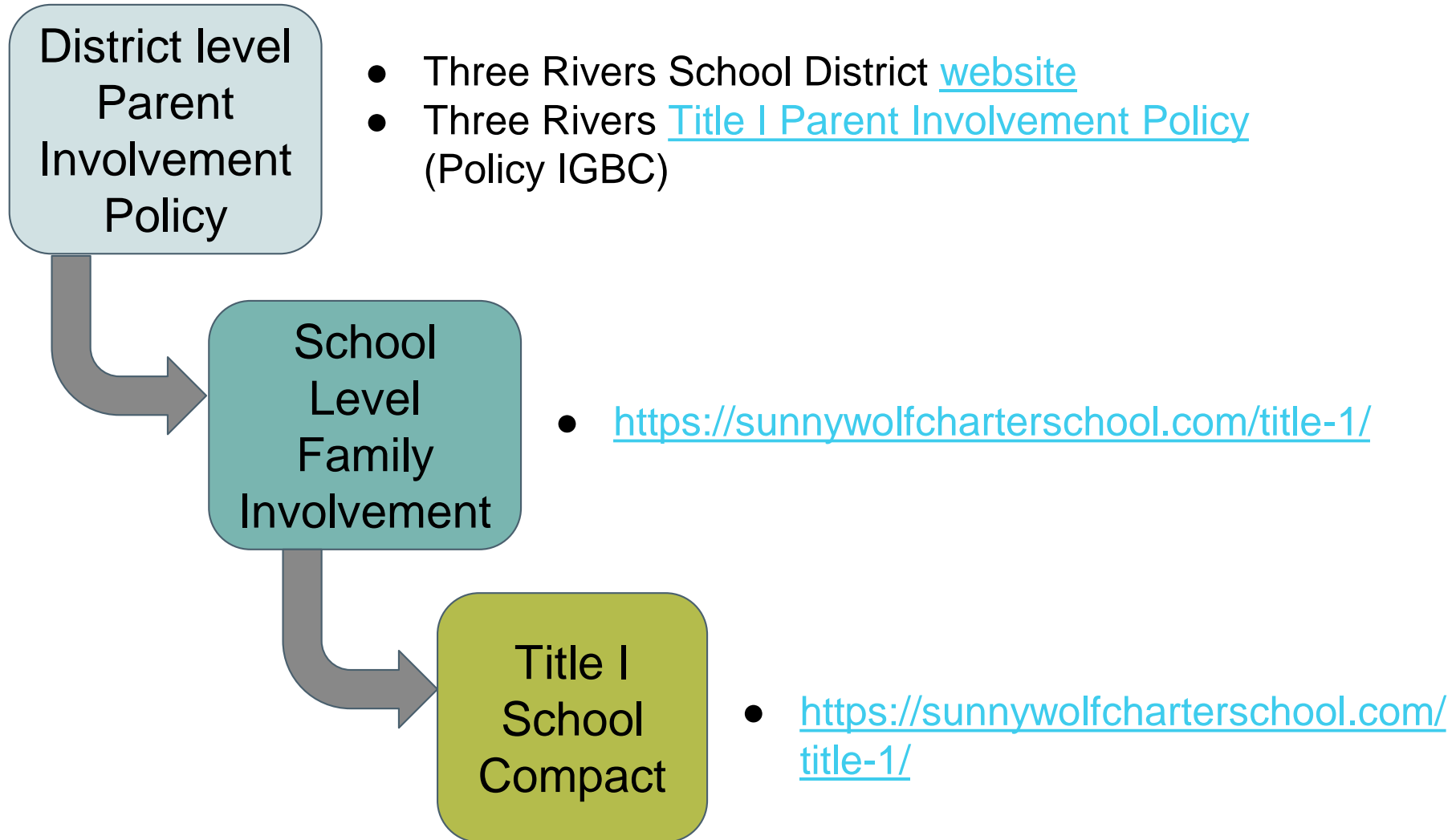


# What Does Our Program Look Like?

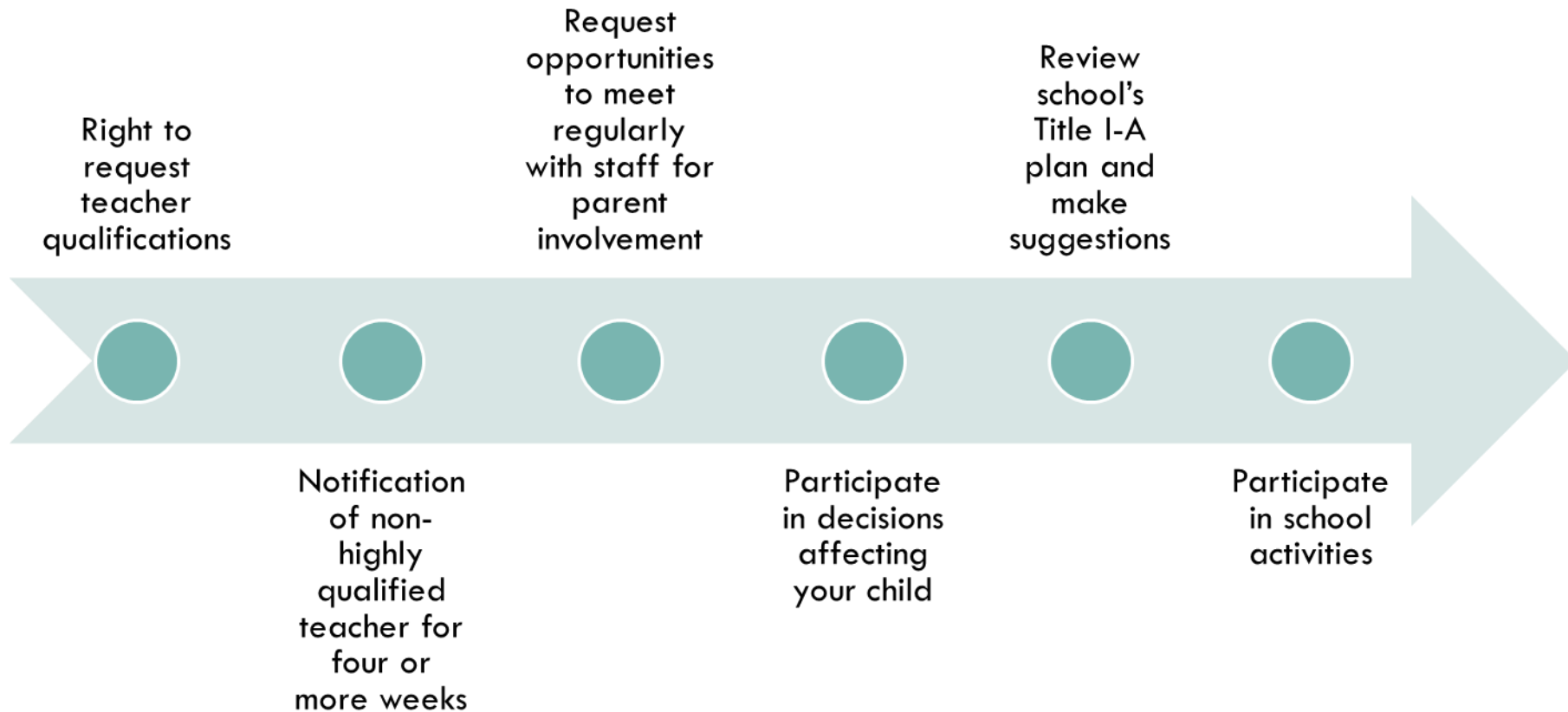
